- ◆ AVMF 2006 Grants to Aspen Valley Hospital total **\$1,107,023**
\$357,023 for a Digital Mammography Unit
\$750,000 for a 64 slice CT Scanner
- ◆ AVMF 2006 Community Grants total **\$385,000** supporting **29** health and human service agencies. Funds raised from the Neighbor to Neighbor campaign support the AVMF Community Grants Program.
- ◆ Awarded approximately **\$69,000** in scholarships to **38** local health care professionals seeking advanced training.
- ◆ Provided approximately **\$38,000** in Direct Assistance Grants for individuals in need of prescription drug and dental care, and medical assistance.
- ◆ Presented **\$10,000** each to **10** deserving employees at AVH from the Dick Butera Distinguished Service Foundation.
- ◆ Presented the AVMF 2nd Health Conference entitled, “Living Courageously in an Age of Anxiety”. Over **200** in attendance.
- ◆ AVMF offered financial and administrative support to the Pearlington Project and Bariloche Project.
- ◆ VIA, Valley Information and Assistance of AVMF, served **112** individuals with emergency and case management assistance, connecting individuals in need with existing local resources.
- ◆ AVMF participated in surveying local senior housing and service needs in partnership with the City of Aspen, Pitkin County and Aspen Valley Hospital.
- ◆ AVMF welcomed **57** new members to our Presidents Club, bringing the total number of Presidents Club members to **133**.
- ◆ AVMF hosted several events for Presidents Club members, including an educational seminar, a members dinner, and behind the scenes tours of Aspen Valley Hospital
- ◆ AVMF produced weekly Grassroots Television show, “Portraits of Giving”, featuring AVMF donors, AVH services, and community health and human services providers.
